



Re- Advertisement: Terms of Reference (TORs) for Consultancy to Conduct an Assessment of the Status of the Auditor General's Report (Supreme Audit Institution Reports) in Kenya

Project Background

Transparency International Kenya through the African Economic Justice programme (AEJ), promoting domestic resource mobilization supported by Diakonia seeks to engage a consultant to review the latest available supreme audit Institution's reports in Kenya with a view to identifying resources lost to wastage and corruption as well as advice on how well the regional finance and investment protocols have been observed or implemented.

Scope of work

1. Review most recent supreme audit institution report for Kenya and identify resources (in figures and as a percentage of budgetary allocation) lost to wastage and corruption.
2. Compare regional public investment protocols to country protocols and to what extent they are compliant with National Treasuries regulations.
3. Make recommendations on closing the gaps and the extent to which the policy and legal framework can be used to fill in the gaps.

Deliverables

- The consultant should undertake detailed research and succinctly provide their recommendations thereof.
- The consultant will be required to develop data collection tools, document all sources of information used regarding each country.
- All such tools used will be submitted alongside the final report.
- Data Collection and verification will be a desk research.

- Documents and or websites used should be referenced appropriately.
- All collected data will be verified by the TI research desk.
- The consultant will be expected to facilitate a validation workshop on the report findings.
- The research shall be limited to finding out the **most recent supreme Audit institution report** as it is recorded for Kenya.
- The report shall be written in English.

Qualifications of the consultant

Minimum 5 years' experience working in public finance management with bias on Public Audit

Able to show experience working on similar consultancies.

Provide at least two referees
